The Melbourne Aces are excited to bring back some key cogs in their past two championship runs, as Jared Cruz, Jarryd Dale, and Jeremy Young have re-signed with the club for the 2022/23 ABL season.

is back for his fifth campaign with the Aces. The right-hander has logged 47 strikeouts in 57.0 innings of work in his Aces career. Young has pitched 37 of his 41 career ABL games for the Aces, while he tossed the other four games for Canberra during the 2020/21 season.

The 27-year-old returns to Melbourne after playing in the Dutch Major League earlier in 2022. Young won eight games and posted a 3.73 ERA in 16 appearances, including 10 starts, for RCH in the Netherlands.


