## **New Scoreboard Review**

At the 2024 Annual General Meeting an action was raised to report back on the feasibility of a new scoreboard for Sunshine Baseball Club.

Out of this action the committee has investigated numerous scoreboard options for The Club. This has included engaging multiple scoreboard manufacturers and investigating scoreboards installed at other clubs, both existing and new.

Scoreboard technology investigated for Sunshine Baseball Club includes –

7 segment type displays that show basic information in electronic form, like the manual version currently in use at The Club,

Hybrid 7 segment display and LED video wall display, and

Full LED video wall display.

Cost options range from circa \$5,500 to scoreboards that exceed \$100,000.

A list of these options will be posted on the club notice board for perusal by members.

The committee has recorded this information and added to the list of projects it intends to progress as priorities and funds allow.

After careful consideration, it has been determined that the completion of the new Indoor Training Facility is the primary focus club's effort and funds from an infrastructure perspective.

Other projects such as the development of the Norm MacArthur Field to accommodate a full-size playing field will be critical to Sunshine Baseball Club over the next 3-5 years in line with Baseball Victoria and Brimbank Council growth of baseball and community. These are priorities for the development of all players and offer significant benefits in the long term for our club.

Of course, the committee, and club, will investigate how a new scoreboard can assist and/or compliment current priorities as part of its long-term development.

**Sunshine Baseball Club Indoor Training Facility 29 January 2025**

*On Thursday 23 January Sunshine Baseball Club received sign off from the building surveyor on the shed construction 'as built'.*

*This means all necessary regulatory requirements identified as part of the building permit have been met. This is a good milestone to achieve this early in the calendar year.*

*The soft netting is currently shipping from the manufacturer and is expected to arrive over the next 5-7 working days, after which time an installation date will be confirmed.*

*The Club has also been in contact with the artificial turf company on installation timelines for their component of the project.*

*Further to above, our trusty band of volunteers was at it again over the weekend.*

*This saw the following work achieved -*

*Carpark drainage made good with the installation of the concrete plinths that were moved to allow for construction of the shed,*

*All power and services cabling was installed,*

*Power points tested OK, and*

*The Indoor Training Facility was thoroughly cleaned to ensure the floor can have a final clean in preparation for the soft netting and artificial turf installation.*

*Sincere thanks to those who volunteered over the weekend.*

*Apart from the works on the interior of the Indoor Training Facility there is still works to do on the perimeter drainage and **we will be seeking your help** over the coming weeks on this task.*

 Back around September 2022 we started the journey of getting our new Indoor Training Facility (ITF) and Bullpen built.  
 We have achieved significant progress over this time with the ITF at lock up and completion works such as storm water, internal wiring and lighting installed and we are in the process of prioritizing and coordinating the remaining works to be completed.

As with everything material and labour prices have gone up and this has added to the ITF cost. We are seeking to raise some additional funds to help to get our new ITF over the line and our gap to final project close out is just over \$20,000. (our new target total is \$95,000)

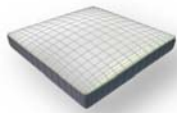
