Dear Members, it is with much sadness to inform you that we have lost another club member, a much-loved Tommy Clayton.

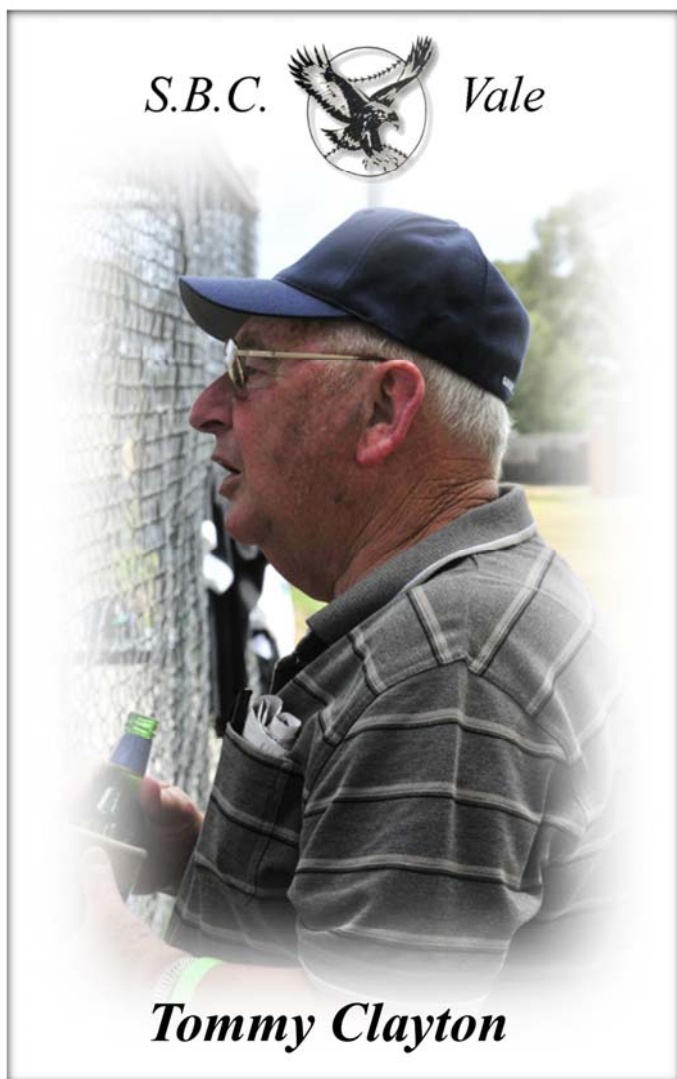

INDOOR TRAINING FACILITY UPDATE

Dear members, we are pleased to advise that we have reached another milestone in regards to the works on the new indoor training facility with the installation of the soft netting being finished yesterday.

There are 2 generous size lanes for batting practice, as well as a section that can be cordoned off for tee work, or other drills. The centre net will be able to be retracted, to then have a fully open space for other types of practice, or group skills and drills.

The installation of the synthetic turf is expected to be completed by the end of February, so we are well on way to our end goal.

There will be smaller jobs to do, such as the electronics, security, purchasing of equipment, storage areas and other incidentals that may pop up along the way, but now we are starting to see the light at the end of the hitting tunnel 😊

Special thanks to the ITF committee and to the volunteers who have contributed so many hours of time and labour to date on this project, it is very much appreciated by everyone.

ITF FUNDRAISER

Hi Sunshine Baseball Club members,
 Back around September 2022 we started the journey of getting our new Indoor Training Facility (ITF) and Bullpen built.
 We have achieved significant progress over this time with the ITF at lock up and completion works such as storm water, internal wiring and lighting installed and we are in the process of prioritizing and coordinating the remaining works to be completed.

As with everything material and labour prices have gone up and this has added to the ITF cost. We are seeking to raise some additional funds to help to get our new ITF over the line and our gap to final project close out is just over \$20,000. (our new target total is \$95,000)

We are very grateful to all sponsors and donors who have helped get the ITF to its current stage to date and look forward to raising some additional funds to help us close out this much needed and game changing project for Sunshine Baseball club.

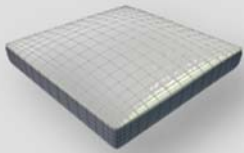

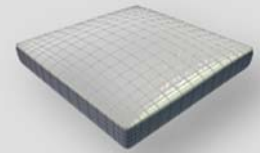

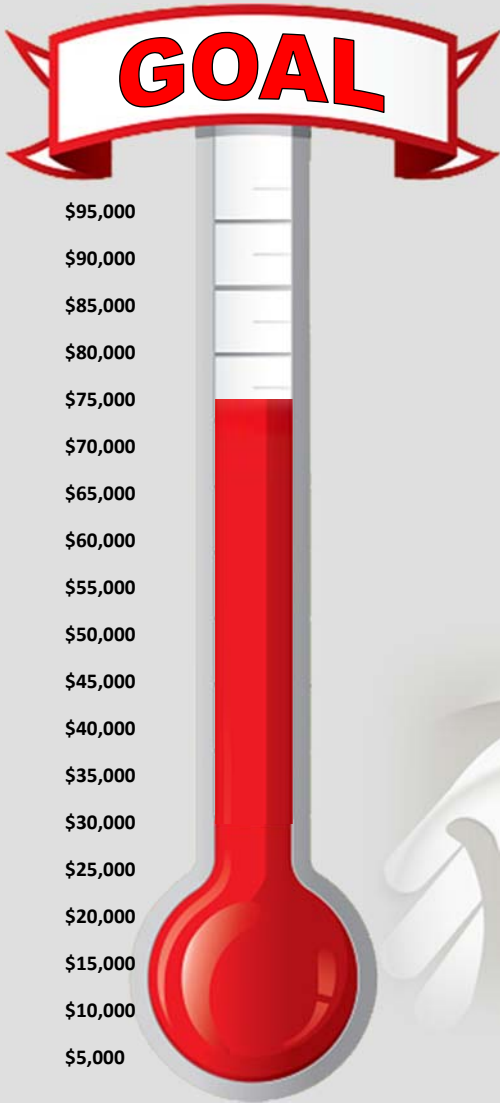
